Launching CB IEP in SD61 2020-2023 (and beyond)

Rationale

The Competency-Based IEP (CB-IEP) was developed to create an IEP that is connected to the BC Curriculum through the Core and Curricular Competencies. The vision involves the student having the opportunity for input to the greatest extent possible and is written using positive, growth-based language. At the heart of the CB-IEP is the development of Student Agency and Self-Regulated Learning and self-determination—providing the student with the ability to make choices and manage their own life.

Year Two: 2021-2022

The goal is to start small, with support. Target= 1-2 CB IEPs per Case Manager in MyEd by June, 2022

Format Options

1. Current Grade 11 and 12 students stay on the BC IEP format, still accessible in MyEd
2. All students with an existing BC IEP in MyEd can:
 - a. stay on the BC IEP format, still accessible in MyEd
 - b. Move to the new format by [Adding a New CB IEP Shell](#)
3. Students with a new designation can:
 - a. Use the CB IEP shell that is generated by district designation approval
 - b. Use the BC IEP format, [fillable Word Document Template](#)
